In The Arts, students create artworks through investigation, experimentation, refinement, and resolution as a medium to express their personal, social, emotional, spiritual and physical world view.

In Media Arts, students use communications technologies to creatively explore, make and interpret stories about people, ideas and the world around them.

In **Visual Art**, students learn in, through and about visual arts practices and develop practical skills which inform their work as artists and audience.

In Fashion, Environmental and Graphic Design, students experience and explore the concepts of designers and artworks, and develop practical skills and critical thinking which inform the creation of their own design works.

The visual, design and media arts facilities at Henley High School provide students with a range of outstanding equipment and resources, ensuring students can create artworks in a variety of mediums, including kiln ceramics.

All Visual, Design and Media Arts students have access to industry standard software including the Abode Creative Cloud suite, Studio One, FL Studio and Ableton Live to enable outstanding high end creative opportunities.
