The Performing Arts Factsheet





In The Arts, students create artworks through investigation, experimentation, refinement, and resolution as a medium to express their personal, social, emotional, spiritual and physical world view.

In Dance, students integrate choreography, performance, and appreciation of and responses to dance and dance making.

In **Drama**, students create, rehearse, perform and respond to drama. They draw on their experience as a source of ideas to explore and depict real and fictional worlds.

In **Music**, students listen to, compose, record, and perform music from a diverse range of styles, traditions, and contexts.

At Henley High School, all Performing Arts subjects from Year 8 include authentic assessment tasks which involve large scale productions, such as Music and Drama Nights, Evening of Dance and the School Musical that are performed to an authentic audience after hours. This ensures students have real world Arts experiences, a high level of engagement and purposeful events where they can strive for excellence.
