## Reinforce

Students nurture positivity, reflect on supportive relationships, adapt to change, support a healthy school culture, express learning passions, consider career choices, challenge biases, prepare for post-school pathways, apply decision-making skills, maintain balance, and evaluate career strategies.

- ✓ Explore potential changes in future pathways and develop strategies for adaptation.
- ✓ Participate in activities that promote wellbeing and resilience.

By reinforcing these skills, students will develop greater self-awareness, resilience, and a positive mindset, crucial for success in both personal and professional life.

### Learning and work exploration

Students are expected to communicate their passions and interests for learning, reinforce career and life choices, and

understand the potential value of entrepreneurial ventures in relation to career and learning pathways.

- ✓ Engage in activities that encourage curiosity and exploration of personal interests.
- ✓ Utilise various resources to gather information about career options and opportunities.
- ✓ Explore the interconnection between work, society, and the economy through discussions and projects.

By actively participating in these activities, students will gain a deeper understanding of potential career paths, develop critical thinking skills, and enhance their ability to make informed decisions about their future.

### Career building

Students reflect on personal qualities for readiness, apply decision-making skills, evaluate.

- ✓ Create and present career action plans.
- ✓ Participate in subject selections and course counselling sessions.
- ✓ Conclude the year with presentations outlining post-school plans and goals.

These activities will equip students with practical skills, foster effective decision-making, promote a balanced work-life approach, and facilitate valuable networking for their future careers.
